NATIONAL ROAD SERIES POINTS

2023



## 1. POINTS ELIGIBILITY

- 1.1 Only NRS registered teams are eligible to score and accumulate NRS Series team points. For clarity this does not include National Teams, UCI Registered Teams, Composite Teams, or Invited Teams.

Teams will only be eligible for points after they have registered for the series.

- 1.2 Only riders who are members of an NRS team (including U19 or Development Riders), invited teams or racing as individuals (not including composite teams) are eligible to score individual points.

- 1.3 Guest riders' points will not count towards the team points however they may accumulate individual NRS points.

- 1.4 When State border closures due the COVID-19 restrict the ability for teams to enter the minimum number of riders, individual points will still count toward team points.

When State border closures are not in place, only individual points of riders from teams that have entered the minimum number of riders will count towards team points.

## 2. INDIVIDUAL RIDER POINTS ALLOCATION

- 2.1 Final Standings (Classics) & General Classification (Tours)

<b>Position</b>	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8	9	10
<b>Points</b>	250	175	150	100	75	50	40	30	25	20

<b>Position</b>	11	12	13	14	15	16	17	18	19	20

Points will be awarded in the order of riders who are eligible to score series points. For clarity, if a non-eligible rider places 5th and an eligible rider places 6th the eligible rider will take the 5th place points.

- 2.2 Young Rider Individual Classification

The following categories will be awarded the Young Rider Classification:

- Women: Under 23
- Men: Under 21

Leader jerseys are awarded to the rider with the most points in each of the respective categories.

- 2.3 Tour Event: Prologue, Stage Results (inc. Team Time Trials)

<b>Position</b>	1	2	3
<b>Points</b>	75	50	25

**Note:** Team Time Trials points will only be awarded to the team not individual riders.

### 3. INDIVIDUAL SERIES POINTS CALCULATION

3.1 All categories leader points are calculated by the addition of:

- Classics: Final Standings Points
- Tour: General Classification Points
- Tour: Individual Stage (including any prologue)

3.2 Individual Rider Series Point Calculation: Ties on points between riders

All ties will be broken in the following manner:

- Highest total number of General Classification and Classic wins;
- If still tied, then number of stage wins;
- If still tied, then there will be two winners.

### 4. TEAM SERIES POINTS CALCULATION

Team NRS rankings points are calculated by adding the individual rider ranking points of registered riders in a team (excluding any guest riders) as follows:

- Classics: Final Standings Points; *plus*
- Tour: General Classification Points; *plus*
- Tour: Individual Stage and Prologue Points

In the event of a tie:

- In the event that the teams are tied it will be broken by the team with the highest number of points obtained by their three best placed riders in the series (excluding guest riders).
- In the event that the teams are still tied it will be broken by the placing of the best rider in the series by the team (excluding guest riders).

### 5. Criterium Champion Points Calculation

All NRS events that include a Criterium stage (or as a support event) will provide the following points structure:

<b>Points</b>	10	9	8	7	6	5	4	3	2	1

Note: The Criterium Champion classification will provide its own NRS classification results. Points will be accumulated separate from all other classifications.
